Saturday 27th: the bulk of the planting will be done. This will be the main

chance for many to make a simple contribution to the neighbourhood, so set aside some time next Saturday, whether it be all day, or just a couple of hours.

Bring yourself, bring your neighbour, bring your children and if you have them, bring some gardening tools. If you know anyone who has a wheelbarrow they are especially welcome!

If you find that you are desperately disappointed because you cannot take part, then you will be cheered by the news that the intention is to meet on a monthly basis to carry out maintenance. Look out for more details.
